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Goodevening

I am writing to register my objection to any further housing development within and around Allscott Meads including the proposed HOA5 and HOA15.

If the proposal is considered, it will add around 165 additional new homes on top of the 470 already recently developed.

This is wholly unsustainable on the following grounds:

Highways - the council's own offices called this area "sensitive to traffic" and cut one site from 350 homes to 105. Very busy at peak times.

Infrastructure and school places - has the impact on our roads, GP capacity and the primary school (with Allscott Meads still building out) actually been reassessed?

Drainage and flooding - many of us have seen the flooded railway underbridge and standing water around the estate. These issues have been left to be "dealt with later" rather than resolved now

Greenfield, not brownfield - Allscott Meads was built on the old sugar factory site. These new sites are productive farmland - the first push onto green fields, and it won't be the last if it goes unchallenged.
